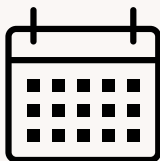

Who is eligible to compete:

All Maplewood students and boarders are welcome, from beginner to advanced. Check with your coach for which Division(s) you would fit best into.



Goals of the In-House Shows:

The In-House Shows are a great way to be introduced to competitions, to practice skills, receive feedback, and just for fun!



Year End Awards:

Throughout the season, points are accumulated at each show and combined for year-end awards. Year-end trophies will be awarded at the year-end banquet (exact date and location to be determined). There will be trophies for:

Times:

A schedule will be posted on the website at least 2 or 3 days prior to the show, along with instructions. Times are estimated and the show may run faster or slower than anticipated. Competitors are required to be at the barn throughout the day to help care for the horses and to assist in cleaning up at the end of the day.

SHOW GUIDE



Ribbons are sponsored by Maplewood Equestrian Centre and awarded from 1st place to 6th place. Division Champions and Reserve Champions will be awarded for each division. Prizes may be awarded at the Show Secretary's discretion. Two Judges Ribbons will be awarded at each show at the judge's discretion. Divisions may be split or combined based on the number of entries.

The point system to determine the division awards will be:
1st place = 6 points, 2nd place = 4 points, 3rd place = 3 points, 4th place = 2 points, 5th place = 1 point.



Newcomer Dressage: \$60 plus HST
Newcomer Hunter: \$70 plus HST
Intermediate I Dressage: \$60 plus HST
Intermediate I Hunter: \$70 plus HST
Intermediate II Dressage: \$60 plus HST
Intermediate II Hunter: \$70 plus HST
Open Dressage: \$60 plus HST
Open Hunter: \$70 plus HST
Freestyle: \$25 plus HST
Scratch Fee: \$35 plus HST



Cancellations:
A refund, less the scratch fee, will be provided for cancellations made after registration up to 1 week prior to the show. No refunds given for cancellations within 1 week prior to the show.



Entries:
Entries must be completed and submitted at least one week prior to the show. Late entries may be able to be added, depending on spaces available in the classes. Classes will be limited for the number of entries in each division. The entry forms are found and completed online.

Numbers: Show numbers will be given on the show day, prior to the beginning of the show. Numbers must be worn for the entire show day either on the rider's back on by use of personal bridle number. Numbers must be returned to the show Secretary.

Dressage

DIVISION DETAILS

All dressage tests can be found on the CADORA website.

Newcomer	<p>Eligibility: first or second year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: w/t dressage test, group equitation, command class</p> <p>Tests: CADORA walk/trot "A"</p> <p>Skills: w/t, halt, sitting and posting trot, should know posting diagonals</p>
Intermediate 1	<p>Eligibility: first or second year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: w/t/c dressage test, group equitation, command class</p> <p>Tests: CADORA Training Test "A"</p> <p>Skills: w/t/c, sitting and posting trot, should know canter leads, progressive transitions</p>
Intermediate 2	<p>Eligibility: second or third year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: w/t/c dressage test, group equitation, command class</p> <p>Tests: CADORA Training Test "C"</p> <p>Skills: w/t/c, sitting and posting trot, canter leads, non-progressive transitions</p>
Open	<p>Eligibility: coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: two "Tests of Choice" dressage tests, group equitation</p> <p>Tests: to be selected by the competitor from the CADORA website</p> <p>Skills: w/t, sitting and posting trot, canter leads, non-progressive transitions, lengthen trot and canter</p>
Freestyle	<p>Eligibility: all competitors</p> <p>Classes: one dressage test, created by the competitor, with music to be pre-approved by the coach</p> <p>Tests: CADORA W/T or Training Freestyle Test</p> <p>Skills: creation of test, selection of appropriate music, performance of the elements of the freestyle test guidelines</p>

Hunter

DIVISION DETAILS

All competitors must compete in a dressage division to be eligible to compete in a hunter division.

Courses will be posted on the day of the show.

A correct simple change of lead will score higher than a horse on the wrong lead.

Newcomer	<p>Eligibility: first or second year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: two over fences (o/f) courses, one group equitation class</p> <p>Jump Height: cross-rails</p> <p>Skills: w/t, halt, sitting and posting trot, should know posting diagonals, should know 2 point in both gaits, expected to trot the o/f courses</p>
Intermediate 1	<p>Eligibility: first or second year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: w/t/c dressage test, group equitation, command class</p> <p>Jump Height: 1'9"</p> <p>Skills: w/t/c, sitting and posting trot, should know canter leads, should know 2 point in all gaits, progressive transitions, can trot or canter the o/f courses</p>
Intermediate 2	<p>Eligibility: second or third year of competing, or by coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: two over fences (o/f) courses, one group equitation class</p> <p>Jump Height: 2'</p> <p>Skills: w/t/c, sitting and posting trot, canter leads, non-progressive transitions, 2 point in all gaits, expected to canter the courses</p>
Open	<p>Eligibility: coach's recommendation</p> <p>Classes: two over fences (o/f) courses, one group equitation class</p> <p>Jump Height: 2'3"</p> <p>Skills: w/t, sitting and posting trot, canter leads, non-progressive transitions, lengthen/shorten trot and canter, 2 point in all gaits, expected to canter the courses</p>

For Competitors and Spectators



Umbrellas

Umbrellas are not to be used, for either sun or rain, as this may frighten the horses.



Parking

"Parking is on the road for everyone except the judge(s) and people with a disabled parking permit. Please do not block ours, the barn's or our neighbours' driveway.



No Smoking or Vaping

There is absolutely no smoking or vaping allowed anywhere on Maplewood property.



Dogs

Maplewood is a dog-friendly place, however, the show day is very busy with lots of horses and people, so we ask that no dogs be brought to Maplewood on a show day.
